Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent nos. 1 to 3 to enquire the matter against respondent nos. 4 to 9 as they have sold the trees and hand pumps of Gram Panchayat without any auction and following the rules.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made a representation dated 29.11.2013 (Annexure P/1) to the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, which is still pending and no decision has been taken thereon. Learned counsel confines his prayer with regard to the decision of representation (Annexure P/1).

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after

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perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, to look into the grievance of the petitioner specifically made in the representation dated 29.11.2013 (Annexure P/1) and take a decision in accordance with law.
