Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for sometime, states that he may be permitted to withdraw the case with liberty to avail remedy of appeal in view of Section 37 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No. 2 state that they have no objection if the appeal is filed within one month from today then ground of limitation shall not be taken, rather the appeal may be directed to be decided on merits.

I have considered the contentions raised by learned counsel for the parties. Without going into the merits of the case, this Court relegates the petitioner to the remedy of appeal. If the appeal is filed within one month from today, the same shall be heard on merit without taking into consideration technical objection of limitation for which the counsel for the respondents have also fairly agreed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
