Counsel for respondent No. 1 has produced a letter dated 11.05.2015 of the Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, addressed to the M.M.Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Mullana-Ambala, Haryana.

It is averred therein, that permission has been granted by Ministry for taking admission against the increased intake in MD(Radio Diagnosis) course from 3(three) to 6(six) students at M.M.Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Mullana, Ambala, Haryana for the academic session 2015-16 with the condition that further admission from the next academic year would be subject to recognition of the first batch of students admitted against the increased intake from 3(three) to 6(six) in the course from the academic session 2012-13 u/s 11(2) of IMC Act, 1956. It is also

pertinent to mention that the Ministry has also regularised the admission of students against increased intake for the academic session 2014-2015.

Learned Sr. counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he would be satisfied for the time being in regard to the permission given for the academic session 2015-2016 but his right be kept open for approaching this Court again on the same cause of action, if permission is not granted for the session 2016-2017, which of course is subject to inspection which has been conducted by the Indian Medical Council of India on 29.04.2015.

I order accordingly.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of.
