The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize/restore the resumed booth No.53 situated at Development Scheme, Chhoti Baradari, Patiala, further prayer has been made for directions to the respondents to decide the representations Annexures P-3 and P-7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has received verbal instructions that representations filed by the petitioner have since been decided by the authorities concerned, therefore, the present Civil Writ Petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such. However, he prays that liberty be granted to the petitioner to file an application for

revival of the present petition in case the verbal instructions received by him are found to be incorrect.

3. Disposed of as infructuous with the liberty as prayed for.
