Prayer in this application is for permission to place on record  
the representation dated 11.06.2015 as Annexure P-12 Colly.

Application is allowed subject to just exceptions.

Representation dated 11.06.2015 is taken on record as  
Annexure P-12.

**CWP No.6233 of 2015**

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner at this  
stage would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondents 1 and 2, to  
consider and decide the complaint of the petitioner dated 04.12.2014  
(Annexure P-5) as also the subsequent representation, which has been  
submitted not only by the petitioner but the other residents of the Kapil  
Enclave, village Begowal, Tehsil and District Kapurthala requesting for

installation of the required LD System so that the permanent electricity connection could be issued to residents of the said locality.

Keeping in view the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, direction is issued to the Chief Engineer, DS (North), PSPCL, Shakti Sadan, G.T. Road, Jalandhar and Assistant Executive Engineer, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., Begowal, Kapurthala-respondents 1 and 2 respectively to consider the complaint of the petitioner dated 04.12.2014 (Annexure P-5) and representation dated 11.06.2015 (Annexure P-12) and take a final decision thereon within a period of six weeks.

In case the representation/complaint is accepted the work shall be initiated with regard to the prayer made by the petitioner/residents of the locality within a further period of six weeks. It would not be out of way to mention here that the claim of the petitioner/members of the locality with regard to recovery from the colonizer has not been adjudicated upon and shall remain open to be claimed by them in accordance with law.
