In the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks a direction for change of her name in the records of Central Board of Secondary Education from Geetu Uppal to Bismanpreet Kaur.

In the written statement filed by the Board, the plea taken was that the requirement of Clauses (c) and (g) of Rule 69.1 had not been fulfilled and the desired change could not be carried out.

Vide order dated 06.07.2015, it was noticed that the necessary and relevant documents had been submitted, as per Annexure P2 and since it was not available with the record of the respondents No.2 & 3, it was to be supplied afresh by the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondent-Board submits that the documents have been supplied and the decision will be taken expeditiously.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the respondent-Board to decide the said issue, within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Needless to say that if any adverse order is to be passed, reasons are to follow.
