A writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, to direct the respondents to stay the departmental proceedings against the petitioner till the decision of criminal cases that are pending against the petitioner, pursuant to FIR No.31 dated 07.05.2012, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, Indian Penal Code, and FIR No.56 dated 22.06.2012, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B, Indian Penal Code, both registered at Police Station City S.B.S. Nagar, District SBS Nagar.

Ex-facie, the prayer is misconceived. The departmental inquiry was initiated against the petitioner and inquiry reports dated 17.05.2013 were submitted to the competent authority, for consideration. And now, show cause notices dated 12.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) and 13.03.2015

him 10 days time to file his replies and indicate, in case, he desires a personal hearing. Though, not indicated in the petition, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that replies to the show cause notices have since been submitted, the matter is pending consideration of respondent No.3.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition so as to pursue the matter before the competent authority in the first instance.
