On 06.01.2015, this Court had passed the following order:-

"The material on record would indicate that the petitioner was permitted to rejoin duties during the pendency of disciplinary proceedings. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even though he attempted to rejoin duties, he was not permitted to do so. There is, however, nothing on record to indicate this. Let the petitioner place on record the order by which he was permitted to rejoin duties as also the material showing that he was prevented from doing so.

Adjourned to 4.5.2015."

As the order was not complied with even by the adjourned date, the matter was adjourned for today. The position is not any different as the requisite material, in terms of the order

dated 06.01.2015, has not been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is yet to obtain the necessary documents to comply with the order dated 06.01.2015 and, therefore, he be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh along with the requisite material.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
