By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits including the gratuity along with interest @ 12% per annum.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case the authorities are directed to decide the claim of the petitioner in terms of order dated 16.11.2009 (Annexure P-3).

Having regard to the nature of relief sought, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the competent authority to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same, in terms of **Mohinder Singh** Vs. **State of Punjab and others** (Annexure P-3), within a period of four months, by passing a speaking order from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
