This writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, direction or order in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to make payment of all the retiral dues and all other consequential benefits to the petitioner with interest @ 18%.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that the entire payment Rs.22,25,442/- stands received by the petitioner on 08.01.2015. However, he states that no interest on the delayed payment has been paid.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction, in case

the petitioner moves a representation for release of interest on the delayed payment, the same be decided expeditiously considering the relevant law on the point.
