RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

A compromise deed signed by both the parties has been produced in Court and both the learned counsel are *ad idem* that the compromise settles the entire dispute, which has been decided in the impugned order passed by the Labour Court under Section 33-C(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. In terms of the compromise, the impugned order has been rendered infructuous and no further adjudication is required by this Court. The compromise is accompanied by Vakalatnama of the learned counsel appearing for respondent No.3-Dilbagh Singh. Vakalatnama is taken on record and so is the compromise.

The petition stands disposed of in terms of the undated compromise, which has been notarized on 6.8.2015 at Patiala.
