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**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):**

Counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to file a representation to the Sub-Divisional Officer, DHBVN, Sector-31, Gurgaon-respondent No.2 claiming refund of the amount which was deposited by the petitioner as a compounding fee under Section 152 of the Electricity Act, 2003 after his acquittal in FIR No.174 dated 04.03.2005, under Sections 39/50 of the Electricity Act and 379 IPC, registered at Police Station DLF, Gurgaon, vide judgment dated 19.02.2011 (Annexure P-1). He states that the said representation shall be filed within a period of two weeks from today with a prayer 'the petitioner had been acquitted in the year 2011 and the respondents have till date not returned the amount which the petitioner is entitled to' and the same may be directed to be considered and decided at an early date.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to file a detailed representation to the Sub-Divisional

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Officer, DHBVN, Sector-31, Gaurgaon-respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by Sub-Divisional Officer, Sector-31, Gurgaon-respondent No.2 within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of such representation.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him within a further period of four weeks. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
