AMIT RAWAL, J (ORAL)

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that against the impugned order dated 1.12.2014 passed under Section 7-A of Employees Provident Funds & Misc. Provisions Act, 1952 (Annexure P-8) the petitioner had filed an appeal on 23.3.2015 and also sought stay of the order by seeking early hearing of the appeal. Since the appellate tribunal was not presided over by any Presiding Officer at that time, in the meantime the attachment order had been issued and the account of the petitioner-Company has been attached.

Be that as it may, it has been apprised to the Court that the Presiding Officer of Appellate Tribunal has been appointed. The petitioner is at liberty to approach the Tribunal and seek for an early hearing of the appeal including the interim prayer.

In case, the petitioner approaches the Tribunal

within a period of one week the operation of the order dated 11.3.2015 shall remain stayed and thereafter, the petitioner would be at liberty to pray/seek for interim stay before the appellate tribunal. It is made clear that interim order shall be valid for a period of one week.

With the aforementioned observations the writ petition is disposed of.
