Mr. Dahiya points out that land of the petitioners has not been acquired for the purposes of National Highway nor any part of said land has been used for the purposes of National Highway though the process of acquisition is under consideration. It is pointed out that letter (Annexure P-7) has, in fact, been issued by the Sub Divisional Officer on the mistaken belief .

In view of the categorical stand of the respondents, the petitioners are not entitled to any compensation for alleged use of the land by the National Highway as sought in the present petition as the land has not been used for National Highway.
