The petitioners seek allotment of plots under the 'Oustees quota'. It is averred that their land fully described in para No.2 of the writ petition and situated within the revenue estate of Safidon, District Jind, was acquired by the State vide Award dated 19.08.2010. The petitioners further submit that in terms of the eligibility criteria given in the Government policies issued from time to time, they fall in the category of 'oustees' and are entitled to allotment of residential plots under the Oustees quota. The petitioners are said to have represented the authorities for such allotment on 23.07.2014 (Annexures P-4, P-5 & P-6). Since the respondent-authorities have yet not decided their claim that the petitioners have approached this Court.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the nature of relief sought by them, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the respondents to consider the above-mentioned claim of the petitioners in accordance with law/Government/HUDA policies framed from time to time and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
