The affidavit of Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab on behalf of the respondents filed in Court today is taken on record. Copy supplied.

The precise stand set out in paragraph-3 of the affidavit reveals that the respondents have permitted the petitioner to continue in service till the age of 60 years and the benefit of two annual increments, which had accrued to him on attaining the age of 58 years too, has been granted, pursuant to the orders dated 24.04.2015 and 27.04.2015, Annexures R-2 and R-3, respectively. That being so, learned State counsel submits that nothing substantive survives in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes this position. However, he contends that the benefit under the

Assured Career Progression Scheme is yet to be extended to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation in this regard is moved by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided, in accordance with law.

For the reasons indicated above, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.
