By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to the respondents to count his service from 01.09.1962 to 11.09.1964, rendered by him prior to joining regular job and to grant him the financial benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice dated 14.07.2014 (Annexure P-2), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order in terms of **Kesar Chand** Vs. **State of Punjab**, *AIR 1988 P & H, 265* and **Balbir Singh** Vs. **State of Haryana and others**, *2004(6) SLR 540*, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
