AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the work allotted to the petitioner has been completed by him to the satisfaction of the respondents. He was allotted the work of D.B Paving and Drain Street, details of which have been mentioned in para 2 of the writ petition and the copy of the work order is appended as Annexure P-1. On completion of the said work, the petitioner is still to be paid the balance amount of ₹2,05,000/- and refund of the security amount of ₹45,000/-, totaling to ₹2,50,000/-. Petitioner has served a legal notice dated 10.11.2014 (Annexure P-2) upon the Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Sunam Road, Sangrur-respondent No.3, but till date, no decision taken or conveyed to the petitioner nor any benefit released to him. He, accordingly, contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied a direction is issued to the Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Sunam Road, Sangrur-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.11.2014

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(Annexure P-2) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Sunam Road, Sangrur-respondent No.3, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.11.2014 (Annexure P-2), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of six weeks. Decision so taken conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
