We have heard counsel for the petitioner and as the official respondents are duty bound to implement orders of eviction, dispose of the writ petition by directing the Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal, District Kaithal, to ensure that all help is provided to the Assistant Collector of the 1st Grade, concerned, who shall, in the absence of any legal impediment, ensure that eviction orders are implemented, within two months of the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
