The petitioner is working as a Home Guard. He claims appointment as a Constable on the strength of exemplary bravery. An adjournment was sought on 27.7.2015 to place on record the FIR from where a conclusion could be drawn on the role played by the petitioner which qualifies as an act of exceptional bravery to be appointed a regular constable. The FIR has been placed on record. The FIR does not reveal that he has performed an act of supreme bravery to justify fast tracking his case for appointment out of turn as a regular constable in Punjab Police.

The writ petition is dismissed.
