AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has sought the relief of annual increments w.e.f. 01.07.2009.

Learned AAG has handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner copy of order dated 17.06.2015 whereby his claim has been accepted. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this view of the matter the present petition has been rendered infructuous but some time limit should be provided within which the respondents should grant the arrears.

In my considered opinion the prayer is well merited.

The respondents are directed to grant the due arrears to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order failing which the petitioner would be entitled to claim the same with interest at the rate of 8% p.a. from the date/s the amount/s fell due till the date of payment.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
