Prayer in this application is for permission to place on record the copy of the MLR of petitioner dated 24.05.2013 as Annexure P-8 and for exemption from filing the certified/typed copy thereof.

Application is allowed subject to just exceptions.

The copy of the MLR of petitioner dated 24.05.2013 is taken on record as Annexure P-8.

CWP No.6773 of 2015

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a direction to the respondent to grant him the security, as according to him, there is a threat to his life and liberty.

Petitioner received a letter from the Khalistan Commando Force as per his assertion. The said letter was brought to the notice of the Station House Officer, Police Station, Qadian, on which the Station House

Officer on 24.12.2014 (Annexure P-7) asked the petitioner that whenever he moves out of his house, an intimation be sent to the Police Station so that the necessary police security can be provided to him. He has further referred to the report of the Station House Officer, Police Station Qadian dated 10.02.2015, wherein he has recommended that personal security be provided to the petitioner. His assertion is that earlier the petitioner had been attacked and FIR No.30 dated 24.05.2013 under Sections 307, 341, 382, 324, 323, 427, 148, 149 Police Station Qadian was registered and the trial of the same is going on in the Court. Petitioner is also the President of the B.J.P. Circle Qadian and, therefore, has to visit different places for his political activities. Accordingly a prayer has been made that he be provided personal security.

I have considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

As is apparent from the communication dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P-7) addressed to the petitioner by the Station House Officer, Qadian, which is with reference to a communication/threat, which the petitioner has received from the Khalistan Liberation Front, according to which the petitioner would be provided adequate police security whenever he moves out of his house. A threat perception, therefore, has been appropriately taken care of as far as the petitioner is concerned. No further directions, therefore, are required to be given in the present writ petition. The same, thus, stands dismissed.
