ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

A writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, directing the respondents to regularise the services of the petitioner as per policy dated 04.03.1999 (Annexure P1), and also the orders passed by this Court in CWP No.12199 of 2000 (Annexure P2).

It is maintained that the petitioner has been working as a part time Sweeper for more than 10 years in Government Primary School, Harijan Colony, Mansa and had represented as regards regularisation of services, repeatedly. But to no avail. So much so, representations dated 01.10.2014 and 23.10.2005 (Annexure P5 Colly.), have also not been heeded to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, let this petition be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the representations made

by the petitioner, within a specified time. And by passing a speaking order.

That being so, and, without expressing any opinion on merits, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as set out in her representations dated 01.10.2014 and 23.10.2005 (Annexure P5 colly), strictly, in accordance with law, within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.
