In this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notifications dated 15.6.2006(Annexure P-1) issued under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (in short “the Act”), dated 14.6.2007 (Annexure P-5) under Section 6 of the Act and award dated 12.6.2009 (Annexure P-7) whereby the land of the petitioners was sought to be acquired.

2. On a query put to learned counsel for the petitioners as to how Section 24(2) of the of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was applicable when the award was announced on 12.6.2009, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdrawn the writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the appropriate authority /Forum in

terms of order dated 24.2.2015 (Annexure P-10) passed by the Apex Court.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies available to them in accordance with law.
