AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that the order of resumption passed by the respondents was set aside by this Court vide order dated 22.09.2014 (Annexure P1) passed in Civil Writ Petition No.12134 of 1997 titled as **Hem Chander and others Vs. Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh and another**. A direction was issued to the respondents to communicate if any amount is due and payable by the petitioners within one month and the petitioners shall deposit the same within a further period of one month thereafter. In pursuance to the said judgment passed by this Court, petitioners had been approaching the respondents for communicating them the amount, if any, due and execute the conveyance deed but no response thereto has been received. Counsel for the petitioners states that despite having sent various communications, copies of which, have been appended as Annexures P-8 to P-10 with the writ petition, matter is still pending at the end of the respondents. Petitioners' counsel in these circumstances submits that

petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to Additional Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the reminder of the petitioners dated 08.12.2014 (Annexure P-9) within some specified time.

In view of the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Additional Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the legal notice/reminder dated 08.12.2014 (Annexure P-9), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.
