For the claim made in the present writ petition by the petitioner, he moved an application to the respondent-School which through letter dated 28.07.2014 (Annexure P-2) has been forwarded to respondent No.2, but even after the passage of about 07 months remains undecided.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take a decision on the letter dated 28.07.2014 (Annexure P-2). I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take decision on the letter dated 28.07.2014 (Annexure P-2), by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
