It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has not been released the amount due from respondent No.2 despite having fulfilled the mandate. The request for release was submitted by the petitioner on 12.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) and thereafter on 08.01.2015 (Annexure P-4), where reminder was issued but no response thereto has been received. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the reminder of the petitioner dated 12.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Managing Director, Child and Women Development Corporation Limited-respondent No.2, to consider the reminder of the petitioner dated 12.11.2014 (Annexure P-3), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of

certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
