AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner is praying for a direction to the official respondents to take necessary action against respondent No.4 for misusing his post and against respondent No.5 for illegally occupying a govt. residential quarter No.10-A, situated at Police Colony, Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved representation (Annexure P-4) to the respondent No.2 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide their representation within any reasonable

time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-4) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
