At the asking of the Court, Mr.Ashwani Verma,
Advocate, learned counsel for the appellant, who is present in
Court, accepts notice. Copy of the application has been supplied
to him in Court room.

Learned counsel for respondent-Insurance Company
submits that during the pendency of the case before learned lok
Adalat of this Court, the Insurance Company has agreed to pay
additional amount of ₹2,50,000/- (Rupees two lacs and fifty
thousand only) to the appellant-claimant and as such, the present

appeal can be disposed of in the said terms.

Learned counsel for the appellant has sought instructions from the appellant and he is agreeable to the said proposal.

Learned counsel for the applicant-Insurance Company has agreed to make the payment of additional amount of ₹2,50,000/- (Rupees two lacs and fifty thousand only) over and above the awarded amount within three weeks from the passing of this order by way of cheque.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in view of above terms, the present appeal may be disposed of.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and going through the contents of the application, which is duly supported by the affidavit, the same is allowed.

CM stands disposed of.
