By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits including payment of gratuity, leave encashment, CPF along with interest @ 18% per annum.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had moved representations (Annexure P-2 & P-3), however, the same have not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
