The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to release the retirement benefits including gratuity, leave encashment, pension, etc.

It is contended that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner had moved representation, Annexures P-2, however, the same has not been decided so far. It is further submitted that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in ***Budh Ram Vs. State of Haryana – 2009 (3) Punjab Law Reporter 511*** and ***State of Punjab and others Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer) etc., 2015(1) Recent Apex Judgments 104.***

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of

with a direction to the competent authority, to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-2, in the light of the judgment passed in Budh Ram's case (supra), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
