AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Petitioners have approached this Court with an apprehension that their connection which is at present running on the urban feeder since 1980 is likely to be shifted to the rural feeder. They contend that they are dependent upon the electricity for irrigation purposes and the paddy season is approaching and respondents have been, on their own, visiting the site for the said purpose.

There is nothing on record to suggest nor are any instructions placed on record or an order/communication that such a process is being initiated. The apprehension, thus, of the petitioners is not well founded, however, if such an action is to be taken, respondents No.5 and 6 may communicate such a decision/order to the petitioners.

Disposed of with above observations.
