1. Whether reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the reporters or not?

ARUN PALLI J. (Oral)

On August 22, 2014, this court had passed the following order:

“Prima facie it appears that the petitioner was dismissed from service after due inquiry on the charge that he had gone abroad and absented himself from duty, though learned counsel for the petitioner contends that leave was sanctioned. The inquiry would suggest otherwise. In any eventuality the petitioner wormed his way into service as is evident from Annexure P-1 which does not even remotely suggest as to why the petitioner was taken back into service after a lapse of number of years of the passing dismissal order. These orders have been subsequently reviewed and the impugned order would show issuance of a show cause notice prior to its passing. Learned counsel for the petitioner has a grievance that the reply was not considered. A perusal of reply indicates that nothing substantial has been sought by the petitioner except to invoke mercy. In any

eventuality before the Court formulates its final opinion, let the inquiry report be placed on record to test the contention of the petitioner that the absence from duty was duly supported by sanction of leave.

Adjourned to 19.1.2015.”

Thereafter, the matter was adjourned twice, so as to enable the petitioner to place on record the requisite material in terms of the order dated 22.08.2014. Concededly, nothing is placed on record, as ordered by this court almost a year ago.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be permitted to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
