AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that the respondent-Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, is putting the garbage into the Sidhwan Canal adjacent the Gill Canal Bridge. It is further stated that the garbage dump is sought to be constructed in the said area adjacent whereof and across the road, there is a Juvenile Justice Home. He, therefore, contends that the action of the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, is not sustainable. He prays that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Municipal Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana-respondent No.4 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decide the same in accordance with law at an early date.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner

and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the

present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Municipal Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana-respondent No.4 to treat the writ petition as a representation and take further necessary action thereon. Decision on the said representation be taken and conveyed to the petitioner within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the writ petition alongwith copy of this order. It is made clear that the petitioner shall supply the complete set of the writ petition alongwith annexures and the photographs attached therewith.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Special Secretary of this Court.
