AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

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Reply by way of short affidavit filed in Court, taken on record.

Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondents states that no fresh poles are being installed in the land of the petitioner and if need be, the proper procedure as prescribed under the Electricity Act and the regulations framed thereunder, will be followed. He further states that single circuit power transmission line is already running on the poles which are in existence, they may be granted freedom to double circuit power transmission line on the same poles.

Counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the prayer made

by the counsel for the respondents and he accepts the statement as has been

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made by him. Counsel for the petitioner states that he is entitled to compensation. If that be so, he may avail of his remedy, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the petitioner further states that some poles which are already in existence require repair. If that be so, respondents must inspect the same and carry out the necessary repairs, if required.

Application stands disposed of.

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In view of the order passed in CM-5150-CWP-2015, counsel for the parties submit that the main writ petition can also be disposed of in the same terms.

With the consent of the counsel for the parties, the hearing of the main writ petition is preponed to today from 11.07.2015 and the same is taken on board.

The writ petition stands disposed of as per the above order passed in CM-5150-CWP-2015.
