RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

This order will dispose of CWP Nos.7460 & 9310 of 2013 as common questions of law and facts are involved in both the cases.

For the last three dates i.e. 7.10.2013, 12.9.2014 and 10.4.2015, no one has appeared for the petitioners. Mr. Nikhil K.Chopra, learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioners have no case to urge since they do not possess the essential qualification for the post of Forest Guards because they have obtained +2 certificates from the Board of Senior Secondary Education Madhya Bharat, Gwalior which is not an institution recognized by

the Council of Board of School Education in India which is the official certifying authority of schools and grants affiliation to recognized institutions. The list of Boards of School Education recognized by Council of Board of School Education in India has been attached with the written statement filed by the State as Annexure R-2/3. It seems that is why the petitioners have abandoned these proceedings for the last three dates. From the perusal of the written statement filed by the State and the stand taken therein, nothing remains to be adjudicated by this Court or decide the issue involved to which the petitioners could possibly have no answer.

Consequently, both the writ petitions are dismissed.
