By this order, we shall dispose of CWP Nos.718, 719 and 729 of 2015. On the request of learned counsel for the parties, facts have been taken from CWP No.718 of 2015.

2. By the impugned order dated 01.01.2015, the respondent has declared the petitioners to be ineligible for the labour contract work and also informed that they would not be allotted any work of the labour contract of the department concerned, namely, the Food and Supplies Department. The order is detailed. However, the order which is akin to an order of black listing ought not to have been passed without affording the petitioners an opportunity of being heard.

3. The impugned order is, therefore, set aside. The respondent shall pass a fresh order after affording the petitioners an opportunity of being heard. Petitioners shall appear before the respondent at the address mentioned in the title, in the first instance at 11 AM on 04.02.2015 and thereafter as directed by the respondent. The petitioner shall not seek any adjournment.

4. The writ petitions stand allowed.
