The Original Application filed by the second respondent has been allowed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench vide its order dated 21.11.2014 [P-4] in terms of its earlier order dated 21.10.2014 in **Vijay Pal Vs. Union of India & Ors., OA No. 1163/HR/2013.**

Learned counsel for the petitioners points out that the Tribunal's order in **Vijay Pal's case** was challenged in **CWP No. 7465 of 2015 [The Commissioner, Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti & Ors. Vs. Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench & Ors]** which was dismissed as withdrawn on 04.05.2015 with liberty to move an appropriate application before the Tribunal.

The instant writ petition is accordingly disposed of in terms of the above stated order dated 04.05.2015 passed in **CWP No. 7465 of 2015** with same liberty to petitioners.
