Instant writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5, guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution of India and Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 has handed over notification No.10/20/2014-IDC/353259/1 dated 27/11/2014 issued by Government of Punjab, Department of Social Security (Disability Cell) whereby Action Plan has been made for redressal of the grievances of

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senior citizens, same is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid notification, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to appear and move representation/complaint before the competent authority/SDM. The competent authority/SDM, after effecting service upon the other side and affording opportunity of hearing to the parties, shall decide such representation/complaint, preferably within a period of three months.
