By way of the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to grant the pension in the pay scale of Rs.37400-67000+Rs.9000 grade pay w.e.f. 01.01.2006, along with all consequential benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioner has moved representation, Annexure P-8, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to consider and decide the representation, Annexures P-8, in terms of order dated 25.07.2012, passed in CWP No.19266 of 2010, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
