Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from Joga Singh representing the petitioner-Jasbir Singh son of Jarnail Singh and counsel for respondent No.6, on instructions from Mohinder Pal Singh, Sarpanch, Village Isharwal, Tehsil and District Jalandhar, state that the writ petition may be disposed of in the following terms:-

- “1. The Gram Panchayat shall constitute a Sports Committee
to be run and managed by the Gram Panchayat;
2. The Sports Committee shall consists of five members,

two of whom shall be below the age of 30 years;

3. The Gram Panchayat shall demarcate 27 kanals of land for the play ground which shall be encircled by barbed wire or a wall so as to prevent encroachments etc.
4. The Gram Panchayat shall develop the play ground and for the said purpose may seek the aid and assistance, including financial assistance from any person whosoever, including the petitioners.
5. The Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar, shall also consider release of a grant to the Gram Panchayat for construction and maintenance of the play ground.
6. The Gram Panchayat shall not lease out this land after June, 2015.”

The writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.

The needful shall be done within a period of 6 months of the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
