The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the daily wages service rendered by the petitioner towards qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-5, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-5, in the light of the notification, Annexure P-3, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
