Challenge in the present writ petition is to the tender notice dated 13.2.2015 (Annexure P-6). The grievance of the petitioner is that the said shop is not meant for the Chemist, therefore, the tender cannot be permitted to be issued.

We do not find that the petitioner can raise a dispute with respect to such tender as he is a tenderer for the allotment of another shop meant for a chemist.

We find that the present writ petition to be without any merit.  
The same is hereby dismissed in limine.
