AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the land, which he has purchased in the year 2007 in village Dona Bhadru, Tehsil Guruharshai, District Ferozepur, which is situated near the barbed wire affixed at the International Border of Indo Pak and is inside the Indian Territory, is not being permitted to be visited/entered, what to say of harvesting his crops. He contends that he has already got orders from the Court injuncting respondents 7 to 9 i.e. Shri Paramjeet Singh son of Shri Amar Singh, Shri Angrej Singh son of Shri Paramjeet Singh and Shri Amrik Singh son of Shri Iqbal Singh. The said orders dated 06.08.2014 and 02.09.2014 are appended as Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively. He has referred to the Panchayatnama, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-6, which also shows that the petitioner is in possession of the said land, however, respondent No.4-Shri Sulakhan Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Guruharshai, Ferozepur and respondent No.5-Shri Chinder Pal Singh, Sub Inspector, Station House Officer, Police Station Guruharsahai, Ferozepur, in connivance with respondents 7 to 10 are not

permitting the petitioner to enter his land or to cultivate the same. Highlighting this grievance, petitioner has approached respondents 2 and 3 by way of representation dated 10.04.2015 (Annexure P-9). He further states that a detailed representation will be filed by the petitioner to these respondents within a period of one week from today, highlighting therein the grievance and supporting the same with the documentary evidence with regard to his ownership and possession of the land in question, which may be directed to be considered and decided by these two respondents within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions that in case the petitioner submits a representation to respondents 2 and 3-Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur and The Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, within a period of one week from today, as has been stated by the counsel for the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided by the Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, within a period of two weeks from the date of submission of the said representation.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioner under signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.
