This Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus order or direction to the respondents to complete the service book of the petitioner, counting his entire work charge service towards pension and to pay him the balance of retiral benefits alongwith interest @ 18% per annum with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the respondents admits the claim raised by the petitioner, however, contended that the benefit could not be released in favour of the petitioner for want of service book.

Learned counsel for the petitioner handed over the photocopy of the service book to the opposite counsel.

In view of the above, the respondents are directed to reconstruct the service book of the petitioner, count the work charge service towards pension and to release the consequential retiral benefits to the petitioner within eight weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.
