Mr. Shyamal Mishra, IAS Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Haryana, Panchkula is present in Court and states that application of the petitioner dated 12.11.2014 was not received in their office. However, during the course of hearing it transpired that the said letter was received in the office of Financial Commissioner on 7.5.2015 and in the Excise Branch on 15.1.2015.
