By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to count his service from 21.09.1982 to 28.10.1983, rendered by the petitioner in Punjab Public Service Commission Baradari, Patiala as Clerk on adhoc basis as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice dated 11.08.2014 (Annexure P-9), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-9), in terms of notifications Annexure P-5 and P-6 and in terms of law laid down in **Hardip Singh and Anr. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors.** 2004(2) SLR 95 (Annexure P-7) and **Sukhdev Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors.** (Annexure P-8), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
