By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks to issue directions to the respondents to release the benefits of service rendered by the petitioner for the purpose of grant of pension and other benefits.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case the authorities are directed to decide the claim of the petitioner in terms of **Mangal Singh and others** Vs. **Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited and others**, in CWP No. 19123 of 2010 (Annexure P-1) of this Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to treat the present petition as representation and decide the same, in terms of Mangal Singh's case (Annexure P-1), within a period of four months, by passing a speaking order from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
