By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retirement-cum-service benefits along with interest for delayed period.

The learned counsel refers to Annexure P-1, the correspondence written by the Executive Engineer, Municipal Council, Malout to the Executive Engineer, Punjab W/S and Sewerage Division No.2, Bathinda, whereby the claim of the petitioner has been admitted by the respondents. However, the respondents are shifting liability upon each other. The learned counsel contends that both the departments work under respondent No.3 and are extension of respondent No.2. The petitioner had also served legal notice (Annexure P-4) for the redressal of his grievance.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without

adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to fix the liability upon the authority concerned. The liability so fixed be credited to the account of the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
