AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging threats to him from the respondents. Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a whistleblower and has made allegation of corruption against the respondents, in which an FIR has been registered and most of the witnesses have turned hostile. He is receiving threats not to appear in the Court and depose against accused. He has brought this fact to the notice of the Special Judge hearing the case. On the basis of this fact, which was pointed out to the Special Judge, an inquiry has been marked to the Assistant Sub Inspector against an IPS officer, which appears to be impracticable as he would not be in a position to take any steps against an IPS officer. Counsel further contends that the threat to his life and liberty exists as also with regard to which apprehension is that he will be implicated in a false case under the NDPS Act.

It appears that the petitioner is aggrieved by the action of the Special Judge on the complaint of the petitioner, as the matter has been

marked to the Assistant Sub Inspector for inquiry with which he is not satisfied.

If that be so, since he has a remedy under the statute and thus, may avail of the remedy in accordance with law against the said order.

The writ petition preferred by the petitioner, therefore, stands disposed of with above observations.
